




Visit https://eyeonwater.com/signup to create your online account. Enter your service or billing ZIP/postal code and your account number. MUST USE ZIP CODE



## How to set up a leak alert on your Orion Cellular EyeOnWater Account





This will be the next page. This is where you set the sensitivity of your leak alert. If you want to find small toilet leaks leaving this set to around 2 gal/hr. is wise but you could set it lower if desired. If you know you have a small leak and do not want alerted just set the gal/hr. higher.

Then please click the arrow to go to the next step.




